## Routine Preventative Exams (Annual Physicals)

INCLUDED	NOT INCLUDED
Complete physical exam and review of body systems (ex: vital signs, blood pressure, heart exam)	Discussing or getting treatment for any new specific health concern, condition, or injury (ie: back pain, headaches, weight gain)
Review of medications and administration of immunizations	New or changes in medications
Past medical, social, and family history	Discussing issues that require a referral to a new provider/practice
Review of age/gender appropriate screenings	

### **Q: Why did I receive a bill if my routine exam was supposed to be covered at 100%?**

A routine preventive exam is designed to focus on your overall health and wellness and to help prevent minor issues from becoming more serious. It is not intended to evaluate, diagnose, or treat new or existing medical concerns.

If you bring up or receive care for an existing health issue during your visit, such as high blood pressure, diabetes, a skin rash, high cholesterol, or headaches, your provider may bill that portion of the visit separately.

Any part of the visit related to the treatment or management of an existing condition may be applied to your copay, deductible, or coinsurance, which may result in a balance due.
